- Choose 1 of the 3 careers from yesterday to be the focus of your project.
- Use the internet to find a professional (and their contact information) in this career that you will interview (preferably someone local).

 - Name
 - Specific Degree (earned from college)
 - Place of Employment
 - Email Address and/or Phone Number
 - Prepare your interview questions
 - This is page 3 of your Career Report
 - See PLTW for Sample Questions
 - o <u>**Get approval**</u> from Mrs. Busch to conduct interview!!!!
 - Conduct interview
 - Have a record of interview (print email, transcript, etc...)

- Write a reflection
 - This is page 7 of your Career Report
 - Why did you choose this career field to research?
 - What are some of the best and worst aspects of this career?
 - What are the most difficult course that you would have to take beyond high school to earn a degree in this field?
- Abstract
 - A brief summary of the content from your career report
 - This is page 8 of your Career Report

Presentation (20 points)

- Your classmates are your audience
- DO NOT READ FROM POWERPOINT
- PRACTICE!!!
- Powerpoint should be bullet points (NOT FULL SENTENCES)
- Summary of the MOST IMPORTANT information you gathered in your report
- This should include pictures and may take multiple slides
- Slides:
 - 1. <u>Title Slide</u> (Your Name and Career Chosen)
 - 2. <u>Interview</u> (Name, Job Title, Place of Employment, Education Earned)
 - 3. <u>Interview Questions</u> (you do not need all of the questions, just a few of the ones you thought were interesting)
 - 4. <u>Summary from Interview</u> (summarize the information you learned from your interview that your classmates would find useful)
 - 5. <u>Career Field</u> (summarize findings)
 - 6. <u>Career Demand</u> (summarize findings)
 - 7. <u>Career Salary</u> (summarize findings)
 - 8. <u>Career Education</u> (summarize findings)
 - 9. <u>Career Reflection</u> (summarize all of your research and give us your overall opinion)
